Immigrants to Ohio

The Herschberg Church records annotate numerous families who emigrated to America. Several of these families settled in Lexington Township, Stark County and Atwater Township, Portage County. The records of the Lexington Congregation in Portage County identify immigrants from Herschberg and surrounding communities. Common surnames include Dreher, Hartenstein, Kettenring (Kettering), Kiefer, Rottman, and Schneider. Families from Herschberg known to have immigrated to other areas of Ohio are Höh (Hay), Angene (Agne, Angeny), Hein, Landfried, and Schüler.

Fully Indexed

- All names appearing in the baptism, marriage, death, and confirmation records (including baptism sponsors, surnames, and given names).
- Village of residence for those people not living in Herschberg.
